### In Love

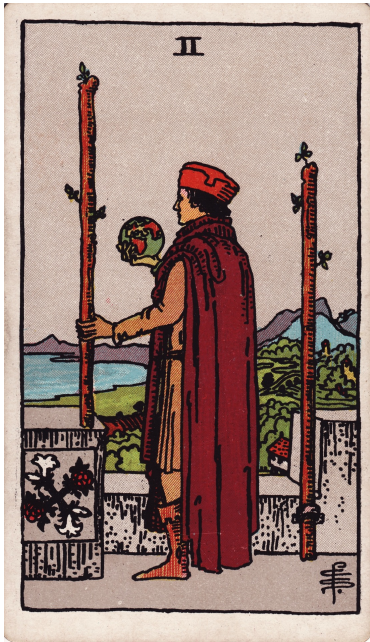
In love, the Ace of Wands can signal a spark of new attraction, a passionate connection, or the courage to initiate a conversation that has been waiting to happen.

## Two Two of Wands

### Upright

### Reversed

Indecision, fear of leaving comfort, or over-planning without movement. The map is useful, but only if you start walking.

For career, this card supports strategic planning, expansion into new markets, and making a deliberate choice about your next professional step.

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# Three Three of Wands

## Reversed

Delays, setbacks, or frustration when results take longer than expected. Reassess the plan without abandoning the goal.

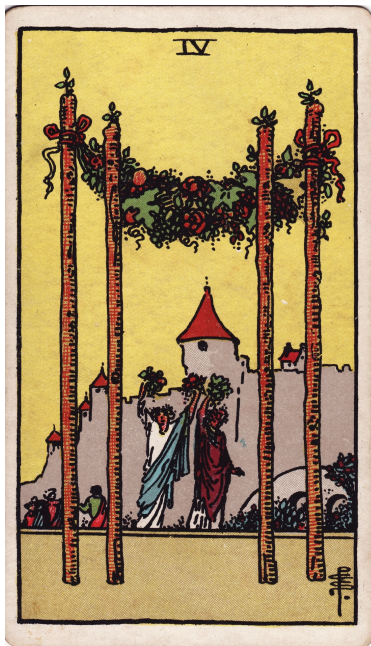
## In Love

Conflict avoidance, petty arguments, or internal chaos that scatters your energy. Channel disagreement into something constructive.

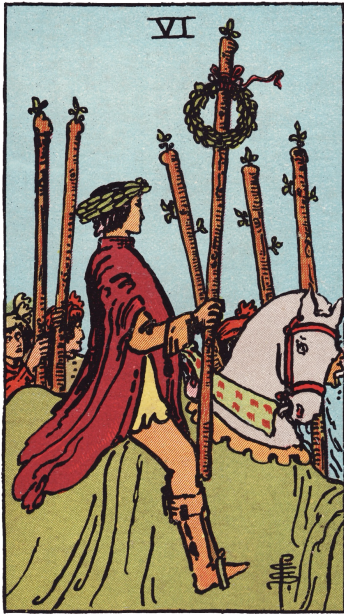
### In Love

## Seven Seven of Wands

### Upright

### Reversed

Feeling overwhelmed, backed into a corner, or unsure whether the fight is worth it. Pick your battles wisely.

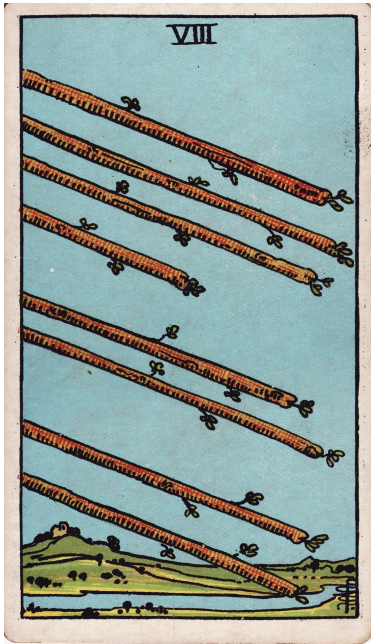
### In Love

Burnout, paranoia, or refusing to ask for help when the load is too heavy. Stubbornness can masquerade as strength.

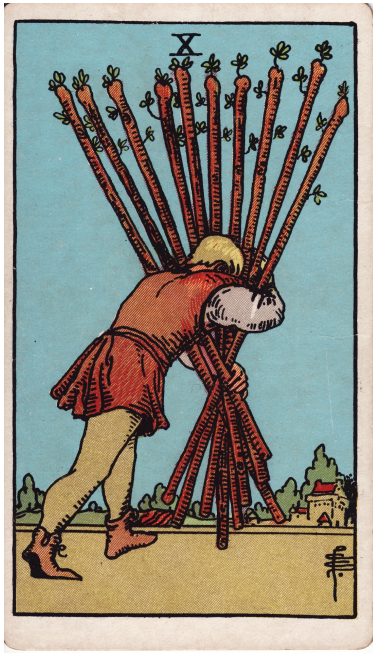
### In Love

Scattered energy, unfinished projects, or fear of starting. The idea is valid — the follow-through needs attention.

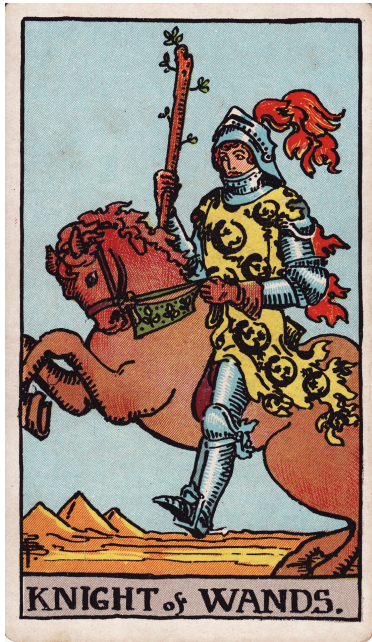
### In Love
